

## Configure a dialup account in OS 9

From the Apple menu, click Control Panels, and then click Remote Access. The window shown below should appear.

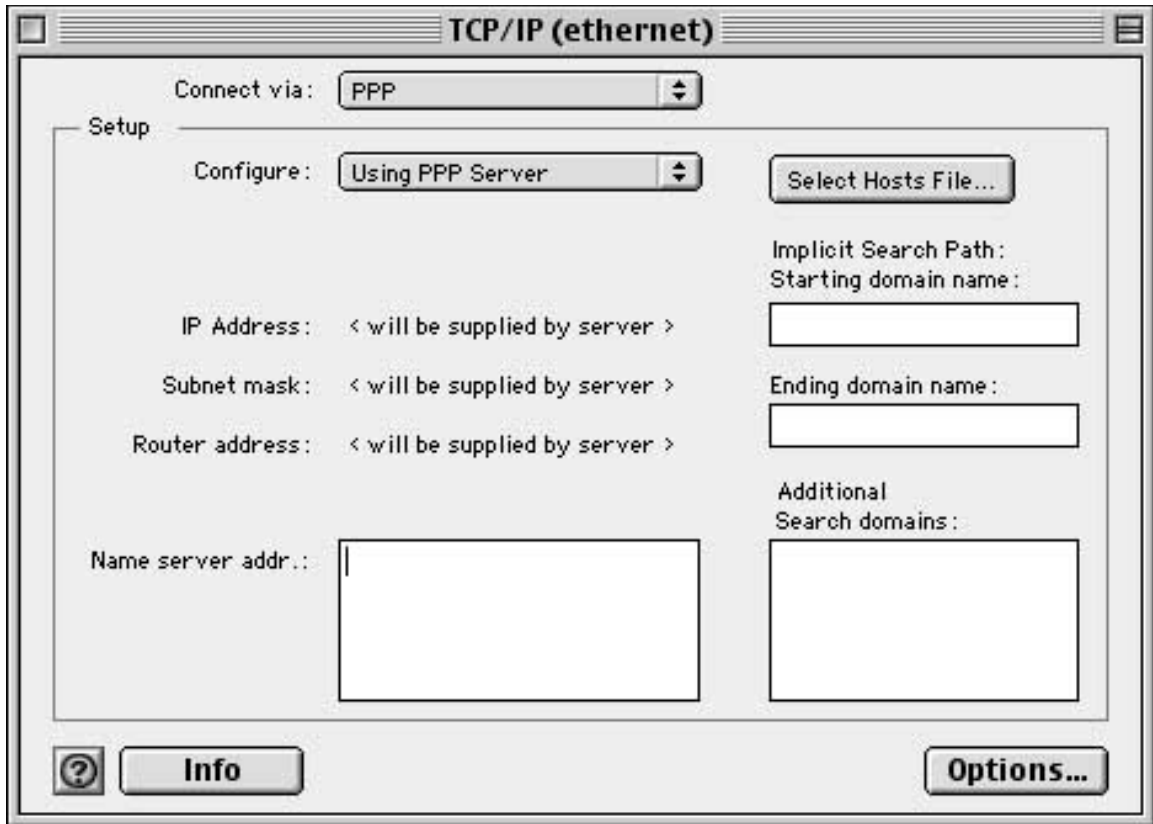
